**Medical Outreach**

We have been chosen through Medshare International to receive funding for approximately \$250,000 worth of medical equipment and supplies. The funding was underwritten by the Atlanta Medical Center. We need to be able to ship the goods to Kenya in the next couple of weeks. We are in the process of trying to raise \$4,000 for the shipping costs. If you would like to help, please fill out the donation form in the back of the newsletter and send it to us before February 28, 2004. We have already raised \$1,000 towards this goal.

The Maasai Heritage Preservation Foundation partners with the Christian Missions Fellowship and the Narok Ministry of Health to support healthcare initiative throughout portions of Maasailand. The CMF has over 80 clinics in Kenya that they facilitate. The clinic located in Talek (Maasai Mara) is old. The facility is going to be used by the local police. The CMF has to raise the money to build a new clinic before they can give up the old. The director of the clinics is one of our board member. The equipment will allow him to be able to furnish not only the clinic in Talek, but many of the other clinics in more remote areas with much needed supplies.

**Building Hope**

The Richard & Susan Daycare Center is in its second year of operations. We are continually making improvements to the center in order to create a model for excellence in global education. Some of the students from the center will go to primary school next school year. We are looking forward to evaluating the progress of the students and determining the value our school added to their education experience. In our quest for excellence, we hired two teachers who are graduates of the Teacher's College in Narok to educate our youth. We are extremely excited about that.

Our facility is undergoing improvements quarterly to insure that we will be able to meet the standards for international accreditation in 5 years.
